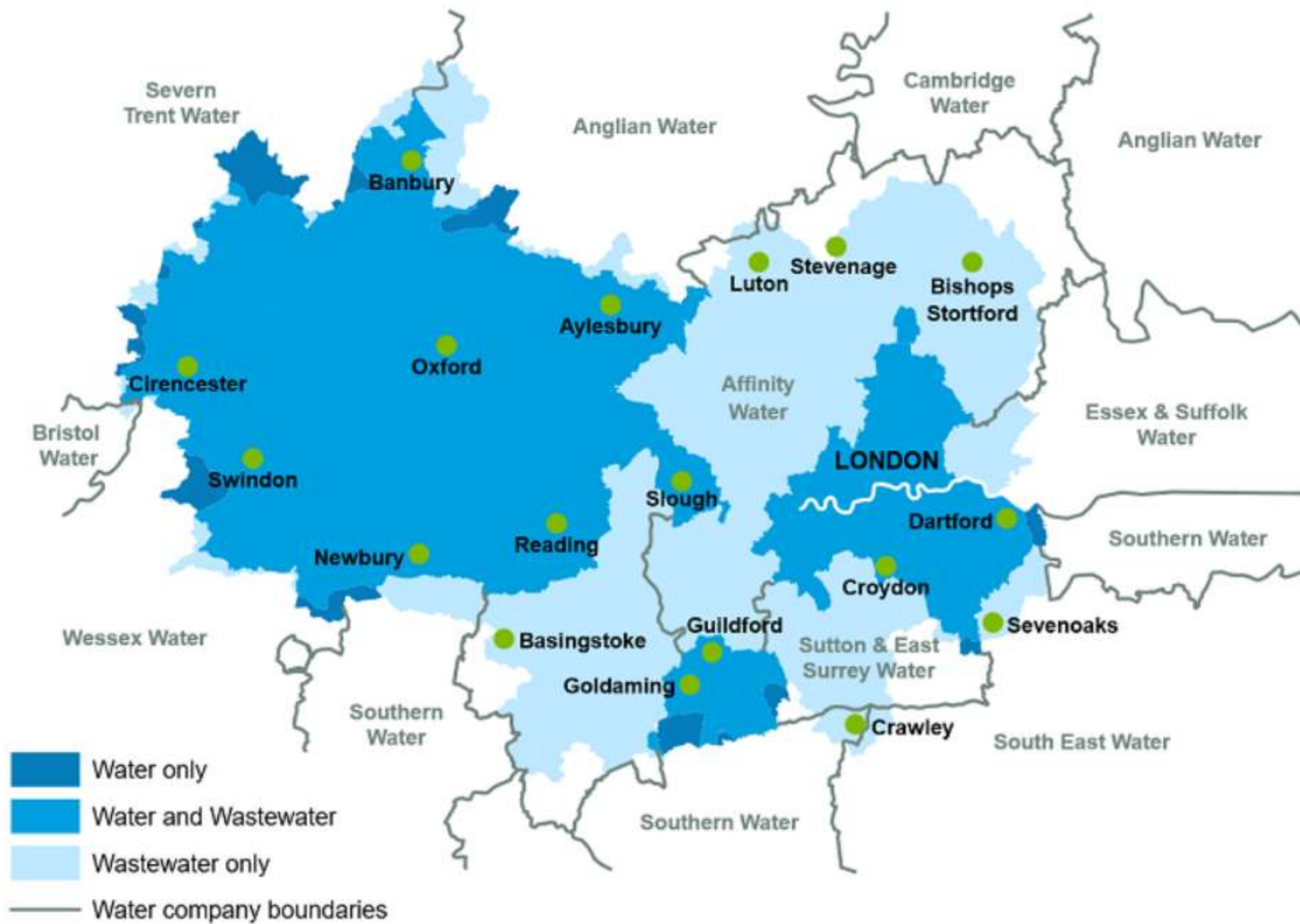
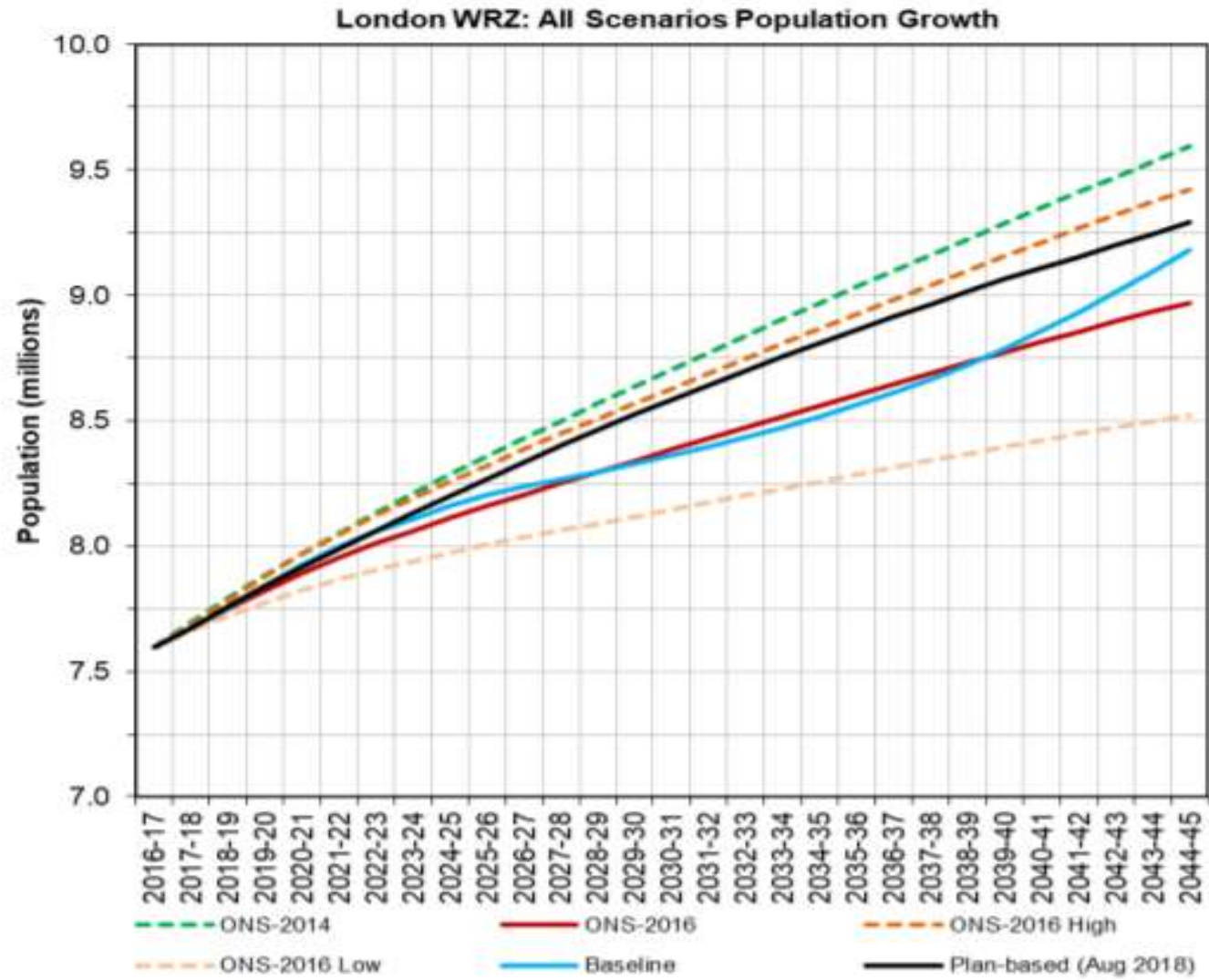
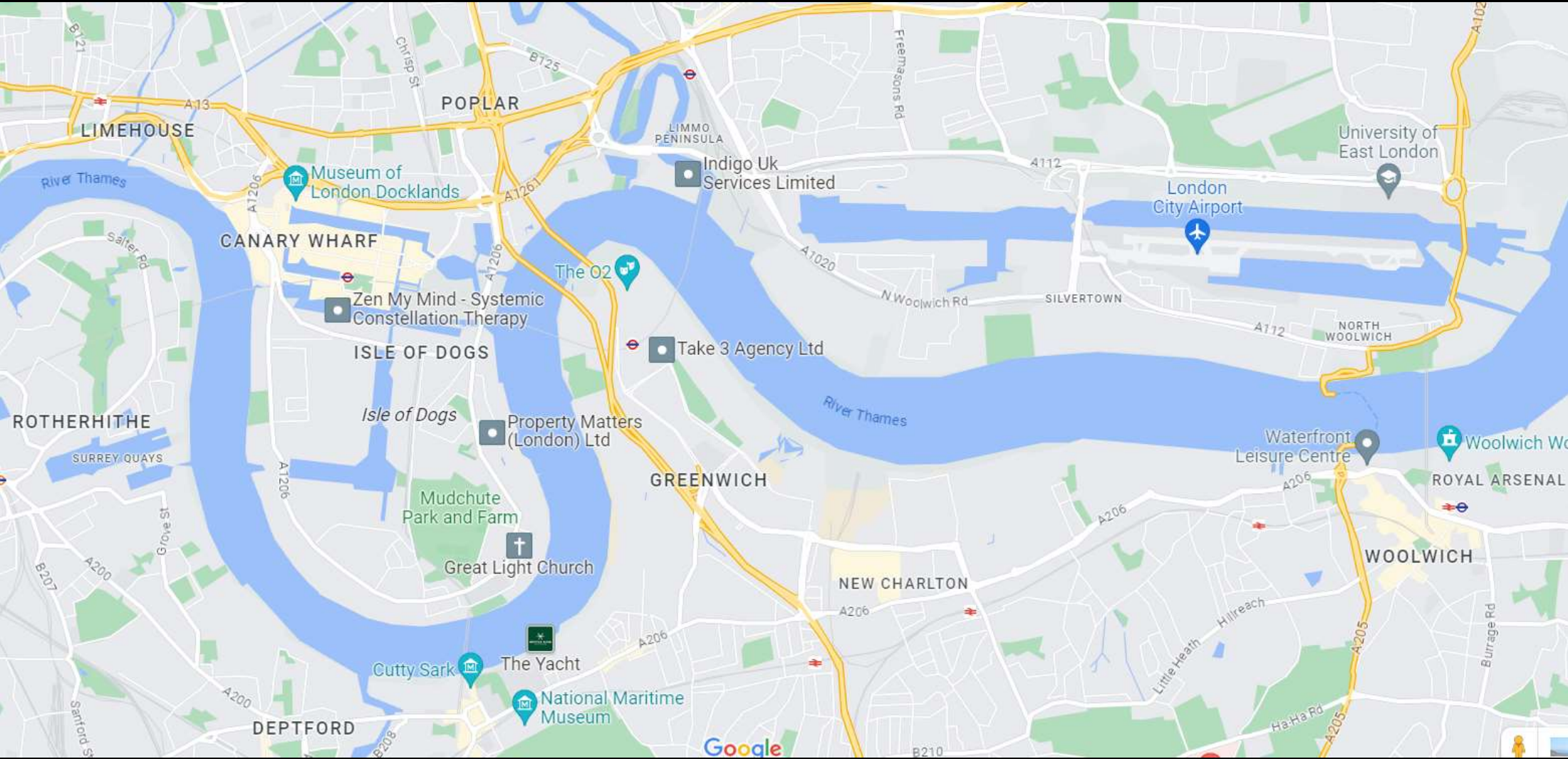


Figure 3-10: Population growth summary: London WRZ
